Brenda Phillips ~ Northern Lights Art Gallery (Full Back Ground of Cover) Manitoba Mixed Media Art

Brenda Phillips (nee Gullett) was born April 29, 1959 in Brandon, MB. A commercial artist by trade, obtained her education at Assiniboine Community College in Brandon, MB. Married on August 19, 1978, to Louis Phillips and on June 14, 1985 their daughter Teri was born. She worked in the retail industry in Brandon and Virden starting her art as a hobby. As she became more comfortable with her talents she began seeking any surface she could paint on. Once she moved to Killarney, MB in 1995 her art went from a paintbrush to the fine art of airbrushing, of which her loving husband had invested into the equipment as a gift for her to explore this unique art medium. She perfected her air brush skills and produced the most beautiful air brushed cake decorating business.

By 2004, Brenda and her husband Louis opened up their L&B Custom Paint and Cycle business, and she began to paint on clothing, leather jackets, motorcycles and her canvas while Louis did the mechanical needs of the business services. She went from a commercial artist to also a fine artist opening Northern Lights Art Gallery, for her artwork, specialized designed soaps and to help promote other local artists. She loved her airbrushing because it gave her work its soft, surreal appearance which she painted from her heart. She began to expand her business into the rest of Manitoba as her talents were being sought after. Became a member of Uniquely Manitoba, was a featured artist at Keepsakes Gallery & Manitoba Art Expo in Winnipeg and had her artwork displayed at the Red River Ex in 2011. Sadly, Brenda passed away suddenly on September 15 this year. Although she may be physically gone, Brenda will always live on through the love of her family, friends and her beautiful art.

Doug Manness ~ Water Wolf Lures (3rd Front Cover Photo) Manitoba Artisan Specialty Gifts

Doug was a loving husband of his supportive wife Kathleen, a father of a son (Douglas) and two daughters (Cordelia & Sarah). Since 1961 at the age of fourteen, Doug began his carving talents making handmade fishing lures. He found wood was a lovely medium and concentrated on creating wooden crank baits (lures) made from tree branches of Maple, Willow, Popular, among many other types. Not being able to afford the expensive commercial lures when he was young, he found that even though it took hours to build wooden crank baits, it rewarded him when he caught fish. He continued to design, paint, test and use them for his enjoyment over many years. and gave many to family and friends as gifts. He enjoyed the making of his lures as much as he enjoyed fishing with them.

In September 1999. "Water Wolf Lures" was created selling all over Canada and abroad. In 2000, he participated at the 2nd Uniquely Prairies Creative Art Show in Edmonton, also in 2004, 2005 and 2011 at the Uniquely Manitoba in Winnipeg. 'Fintastic' fishing lures hook anglers, collectors as a Manitoban creates pieces of 'folk art' at Oak Bluff shop, was written by Bill Redekop of Winnipeg Free Press - May 10 2004. In 2004, Recognized in the Manitoba Legislative Assembly Minutes by Mrs. Mavis Taillieu (Morris): "Mr. Speaker, I am pleased to put a few words on the record about a constituent of mine, Mr. Doug Manness, of Springstein. Mr. Manness is a crafter of fishing lures that are just as much for collectors as they are for fishing." Doug sadly passed away due to cancer on July 8, 2011 at the age 63 years, He was a talented Folk Artist with an amazing ability to create woodcarving with a purpose.
